INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS FOR DYNOMAX KIT 38446

2011-07 Jeep Wrangler JK 3.8L (2-door)

Danger Warning: Should the purchaser decide to install any exhaust product at home, be warned that passenger car or light duty truck/van bumper jacks are intended for emergency use only. The use of frame contact jack stands, in conjunction with a floor jack as main support, is highly recommended to minimize accidental dropping of a vehicle during the installation process.

Note: Read all instructions before starting any work.

- 1. Remove the O.E. exhaust from behind the catalytic converters. Lubricate the rubber isolators with WD-40, or a similar product, to aid in removal of the metal rod hangers.
- 2. Install Dynomax front intermediate pipe **53788** and rear intermediate pipe **54753**. Insert the rod hangers into the rubber isolators. Slightly tighten the 2 ¹/₂" clamps.
- 3. Install Dynomax *VT* muffler **17959**. The driver side OE rod hanger at the front of the muffler is not used for this Dynomax system. Slightly tighten the 2 1/2" clamp that connects this muffler to the outlet of the rear intermediate pipe.
- 4. Install Dynomax tail pipe **51079** and SS tip **36486**. Be sure to insert the metal rod hanger into the rubber isolator. See the system diagram on the back page of these instructions.
- 5. Beginning at the inlet end, align the system components and fully tighten all the clamps.
