




2013-12 Jeep Wrangler, Wrangler Unlimited w/3.6L eng.





WARNING – Do not attempt to cut exhaust while installed on vehicle; damage to oil pan, wiring and brake lines can result.

- 1)
 Park vehicle on a level surface. Set the parking brake and chock rear wheels. Disconnect the negative ground cable from the battery.
- 3) \Box Raise the rear of the vehicle and support the frame with jack stands.
- 5) Loosen the rear crossover pipe to muffler pipe clamp. See Illustration 1.

- 8) \Box Remove crossover pipe.
- 9) Mark and cut driver side of crossover pipe 10" from end of pipe. See Illustration 2.



- 11) 🗆 Install driver side section of cut crossover pipe on muffler pipe. Make sure crossover pipe is fully engaged on muffler pipe.
- 12)
 Line up flanges and loosely install flange bolts. Tighten crossover pipe to muffler pipe clamp.

- 15)
 Line up flanges and loosely install flange bolts.
- 16) 🗆 Install and tighten supplied clamps. Align driver side clamp so nuts face to the side toward the driveshaft. Align passenger side clamp so nuts face down. See illustration 4.


