

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

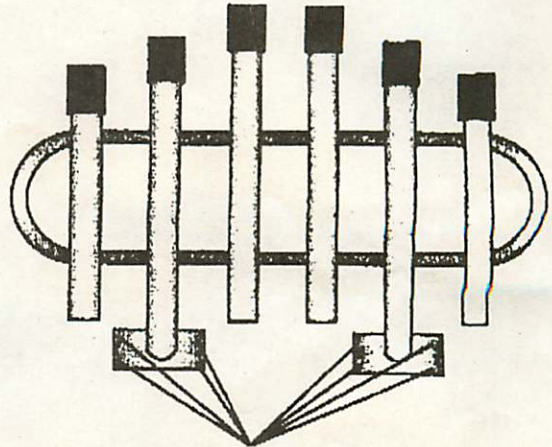
CAUTION: This installation will require two people. While the rod rack is not extremely heavy it could possibly fall and caution should be taken to prevent possible injury, **NEVER** lay under the rod rack unless it is firmly supported. **ALWAYS** read and understand any instructions and safety precaution that came with your power tools before using. **ALWAYS** plan your installation before beginning. These instructions may not apply to all installations. If you feel uncomfortable or doubt your ability to perform this installation consult a professional.

1

Remove tags and tag holder from front bumper if installed

2

With a helper holding rod rack in position against bumper, mark the mounting plate with location for four (4) holes. If rod rack has two mounting plates, mark both plates. The number of holes needed varies with bumper configuration but no less than three (3) holes should be used on each plate. (NOTE: some rod racks come pre-drilled, if that is the case skip this step.)

Drill holes at marked locations using a 1/4" drill bit. (NOTE: some rod racks come pre-drilled, if that is the case skip this step.)

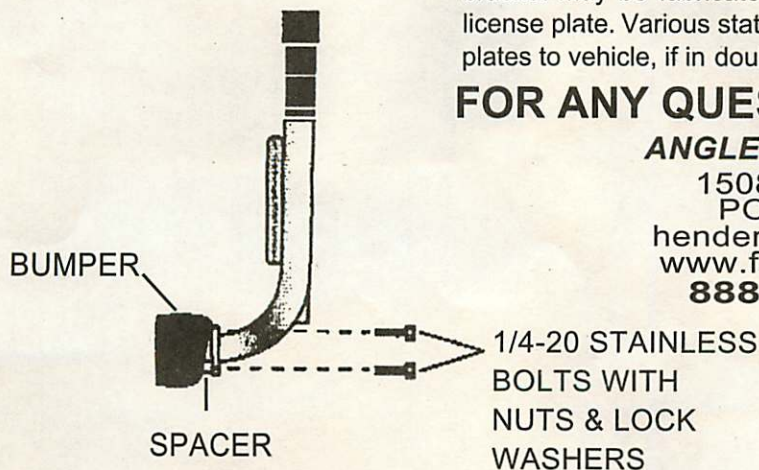
With helper holding the rack in position against bumper. mark the location of the drilled holes on the bumper. Remove rack and drill 1/4" holes in the bumper. (IMPORTANT: rod rack should be mounted square on the vehicle.)

Reposition rod rack against bumper. Insert 1/4-20 bolts in top holes. (NOTE: Stainless Steel hardware is recommended.) Place lock washer and nut on top bolts. Tighten loosely. Insert 1/4-20 bolts in bottom holes. Use a spacer between rod rack and bumper if bumper is not vertical. Rod rack should be mounted vertically. Tighten all bolts securely.

If possible re-attach license plate holder and license plate to bumper. If not possible attach license plate securely to either the rod rack or the bumper. **DO NOT** drill hole in the rod rack to attach license plates, the screws could severely scratch the fishing rods in the rack. A mounting bracket may be fabricated and clamped to the rod rack to hold license plate. Various state laws apply to the mounting of license plates to vehicle, if in doubt consult a professional.
