A WARNING

Before you install this kit, read and understand all instructions, warnings, cautions, and notes in this instruction sheet and in the vehicle owner's manual.

Proper installation of this kit requires knowledge of the factory recommended procedures for removal and installation of original equipment components. Before Starting Installation

NOTE

Kit parts are prefaced by the word *kit* and appear in **bold** print.

- 1. Carefully read all warnings and instructions completely before beginning.
- 2. Verify all parts have been received in this kit by checking the parts list at the end of this document.

NOTE

If parts are missing from kit, please be prepared to provide the following information:


- 1. Name of purchase location
- 2. Bar Code on side of box
- 3. Date above bar code
- 4. Date inside box cover
- 5. Inspector # from inside box cover
- **3.** Only install this kit on the vehicle for which it is specified. If anytime during the installation you encounter something different from what is outlined in the instructions, call technical support at (928) 636-7080.
- **4.** Park vehicle on a clean, dry, flat, level surface and block tires so vehicle cannot roll in either direction.

Engine Compartment


1. Disconnect both battery cables. Disconnect negative cable first, then positive cable.

Prepare to Install Bumper


1. Remove four bolts, two push clips and lower splash guard from lower crush zone and front bumper.




- **2.** Disconnect fog lights wiring harnesses from fog lights if equipped.
- **3.** Remove wiring harness and clips from lower crush zone.



4. Remove four nuts, four spacer plates and front bumper from frame horns.



- 5. Remove eight screws and two fog lights from front bumper.
- 6. Note: 2010 & 2011 Models require a small amount of trimming to lower crash bar. Mark and trim (using a cut off wheel) a small amount of overhanging sheet metal from lower crash bar so *kit* foglight bumper may sit flush on crash bar.




Install Bumper

NOTE

Bumper is designed to work with OE lights.


1. OE Fog Lights

a. Install *kit* OE light bracket to mount OE lights onto *kit* bumper installing OE lights at the same time with eight *kit* bolts (1/4"-20 x 1"), eight *kit* washers (1/4" SAE) and eight *kit* nuts (1/4"-20 Nylock)..



Kit **Bolts** (1/4"-20 x 1"), *Kit* **Washers** (1/4" SAE), *Kit* **Nuts** (1/4"-20 Nylock)

2. Place kit "D-ring" bracket into kit bumper slots.



3. Install *kit* **bumper** onto frame horns with eight *kit* **bolts** (1/2"-13 x 1-1/4" button) and eight *kit* **nuts** (1/2"-13 Flange). DO NOT TIGHTEN.



4. Note: 2010 & 2011 Models mark and drill passenger side lower crash bar. Mark and drill (using a 1/2" drill bit) passenger side lower crash bar so *kit* Bolts (1/2-13x1 1/4 botton head) may sit flush through bumper.




Drill 1/2" hole on Passenger side crash bar.

Install *kit* bumper onto lower crush zone with four *kit* nuts (1/2"-13 flange), four *kit* large washers (1/2" ID), and four *kit* bolts (1/2"-13 x 1-1/4" button). TIGHTEN all *kit* bumper hardware.



6. Connect fog light wiring harnesses onto fog lights.



After Completing Installation

Engine Compartment

1. Connect both battery cables. Connect positive cable first, then negative cable.

Miscellaneous

- 1. Check all fasteners to ensure they are tight.
- **2.** Ensure all wires, hoses, cables, etc. are properly connected and there is ample slack.

Dynamic Vehicle Check

- 1. Check steering in both directions to ensure that there is no bind. Check operation of clutch, brake system, and parking brake. Check operation of transmission and transfer case. Ensure there is full engagement in all gears and 4WD ranges. Check battery connections and electrical component operations. Test-drive vehicle.
- 2. Check steering and suspension in all positions to ensure that there is no bind and adequate clearance between all moving, fixed, and heated members. Check tire-to-bumper clearance and ensure no contact in any position. Test-drive vehicle.

Retorque all fasteners after 500 miles and after off road use. All body lift components should be visually inspected and fasteners retorqued during routine vehicle servicing.

Performance Automotive Group does not recommend any particular wheel and tire combinations for use with its products and cannot assume responsibility for the customer's choice of wheels and tires. Refer to your owner's manual for recommended tire sizes and warnings related to the use of oversized tires. Larger wheel and tire combinations increase stress and wear on steering and suspension components, which leads to increased maintenance and higher risk for component failure. Larger wheel and tire combinations also alter speedometer calibration, braking effectiveness, center of gravity, and handling characteristics. Consult an experienced local off road shop to find what wheel and tire combinations work best with your vehicle.
