- 5/16 or 8mm socket, nutdriver, or med flat screwdriver
- 10 mm socket or wrench
- Ratchet & extension

Installation Instructions:

1. Loosen clamps for the air ducts at throttle body and filter box. Disconnect the (2) rubber vent hoses at the plenum box. Pull the plenum box straight off the throttle body & rubber mounts. Remove the rubber coupler from the throttle body if it separates from the plenum box. Lift the filter box straight up & out of vehicle.

2. Remove nut from inner fender above coil spring seat (see **Photo A**). Remove nut from top ECM bracket (see **Photo B**). Remove bolt from radiator core support (see **Photo C**). Install Magnum Force housing panel using these attachment points (see **Photo D**). The (2) spacer washers will be used under the tab on the radiator core support.

3. Install 22" Trim on top edge of panel. The notch is placed in the corner with the short leg towards the fender and the longer leg towards the radiator core support. The shorter edge trim is used to line the hole in the panel. Start & end the trim at the bottom of the hole for appearance.

4. Install the Flexible Coupler over the short end of the intake tube. It may take some effort & can be assisted by hand from the inside of the coupler. Slide it on until the edge touches the vent tube. Pass the other end of the tube thru the hole in the panel. Slide the coupler over the throttle body. This will also take a bit of effort but can be done without tools. It helps to push from the front side of the intake tube while working the coupler evenly over the throttle body. When evenly installed the large hose clamps can be opened up and placed over the coupler & tightened. Install clamps with adjustment screws away from throttle linkage (see **Photo E**).

5. Slide existing vent hoses onto vent tube connections & secure with small hose clamps.

6. Install your pre-oiled AFE filter onto the end of the intake tube & secure with the provided clamp (do not use any oil).

7. Your installation is now complete. Double-check all connections 8 make sure there is no interferences with hoses, wires, etc.


