SUBJECT: Part #90710 Gas Tank Skid Plate Installation Instructions

Important: This installation is best done with an empty tank of fuel. It will be difficult to manage the tank with too much fuel in it. Also note that this is a replacement skid plate, the existing plate will need to be removed in order to install this one.

- 1. Begin by supporting the gas tank with a floor jack. A piece of wood to distribute the load across the skid will also help in lowering it steadily.
- 2. Along the front and back edges of the skid are bolts holding it in place. Remove these bolts.
- 3. Lower the skid. You may be able to let your tank hang while you swap the skid out.
- 4. Inspect your gas tank straps and if not in good shape, replace them. Rusty straps should not be re-used.
- 5. Load your new skid onto the jack and reverse the process to raise it into place.
- 6. Bolt the new skid into place and lower the jack out of your way

Be careful not to damage any fuel lines or filler neck hoses while doing this installation.
