ADJUSTABLE TIRE STEP INSTRUCTIONS



The **ROCKWOOD TIRE STEP** allows easy underhood and rooftop access for most pickups, SUV's, high clearance and lifted vehicles. Constructed of fully welded, heavy gauge fabricated steel for rugged reliability.

SAFETY INFORMATION

A DANGER FALL HAZARD!

Step surface can become slippery.



- DO NOT use in rain or snow conditions. DO NOT use if platform is wet.
 DO NOT stand on platform with wet shoes.
- Use only on a vehicle located on a flat, level and firm surface. Vehicle parking brake must be set and wheels chocked to prevent movement.
- DO NOT use on a wheel that is jacked.
- DO NOT exceed rated weight capacity of 300lbs [158kg.].
- Use only to support one person.
- Weight must be centered on platform.

A CAUTION PINCH HAZARD!

 To avoid possible personal injury, keep hands and fingers free of moving parts when adjusting or folding Tire Step.

OPERATION

- Unfold unit so that the Upright Supports are 90° to the Upper Tire Loop and Step platform (FIG 1).
- Place Upper Loop up and over top of tire so that the Upper Loop contacts the upper, inner sidewall.
 The left and right Upright Supports should rest against the outer face of the tire on both sides of the rim.
- The Step should always be at a level position before use.
 NOTE: The Upper Loop is adjustable to accommodate varying tire widths.


To Adjust Loop width:

Depress both Spring Pins to clear outer Side Member holes then push Loop inward for decreased tire width and pull Loop outward for increased tire width (FIG 2).

The Step height may be raised if required by removing the Step pivot bolts, moving pivot points to a higher set located on the Upright Supports and reassembly (FIG 3).

• Fits 8" to 10" wide tires.
