



# **Entry Step Installation Instructions**

# Orient Step To Vehicle


The front of the Weldments will be marked with one 1/4" hole (Driver's Side) or two 1/4" holes (Passenger Side). The form on the Step Covers should be toward the front of the vehicle.

**Installing Entry Step with 2" or 3" Body Lift** If you are installing the Entry Step on a vehicle with a 2" or 3" body lift, use the Driver's Side Weldment on the passenger side. Rotate it 180° to keep the 1/4" holes toward the front of the vehicle. Use the Passenger Side Weldment on the driver's side in the same fashion. Follow the remaining steps as normal.

#### Assemble Step Covers to Weldments

Remove the Step Covers from the protective bags.

Lay the driver's side cover upside down and place the weldment on top. Align the holes in the weldment brackets with the holes in the cover. Install two 1/4" x 3/4" Hex Washer Head Sheet Metal Screws. Do not over tighten the screws.






Do not allow the Entry Step Weldment Brackets or Bolts to pinch or crush

the tubing or cables against the vehicle frame.

#### 3 Install Entry Step to Vehicle Frame

Slide the Entry Step Weldment Brackets over the vehicle frame with the front bracket about 3" from the front body mount. Slide the front weldment bracket under the emergency brake cable (YJ only) and tube bracket on the driver's side. Install a 1/2"-13 x 5" Bolt (YJ/TJ) or 1/2"-13 x 6" Bolt (CJ7) and a 1/2"-13 Nylon Jam Nut through each weldment bracket. Make sure that the brake cables are outside of the bolt and that it does not pinch or crush the tubing or cables. Tighten the bolts to at least 150 lbs of torque.

# 4 Secure Tubing and Cables

Use a 6" Cable Tie to secure the tubing and cables to the Weldment Bracket mounting bolt on each side of the vehicle.

### **Limited Warranty**
