

# **Installation Instructions**

# OFF ROAD RACK SYSTEM 87-06 TJ WRANGLER (2door)

PART# (11701.01) AND (11701.02)

#### **NOTE:** Not for use with Wrangler Unlimited

Note: Please read this information completely before proceeding with installation. To obtain correct fitment, we recommend you follow these step-by-step instructions carefully. Please take care when installing this product to protect the finish of your vehicle and rack.




### WE RECOMMEND THAT TWO PEOPLE INSTALL THE OFF ROAD RACK. SEVERAL STEPS REQUIRE A SECOND PERSON TO MAKE THE INSTALLATION EASIER.

Important: You are going to have to remove the bolts from your door hinge. DO NOT OPEN DOOR WHILE THE BOLTS ARE REMOVED!!! YOUR DOOR WILL GO OUT OF ALIGNMENT.


#### Front Uprights: Installation Instructions

- (1) Place the adhesive backed gaskets on the front uprights to protect the vehicle from scratches.
- (2) Remove the factory windshield hinge and lower door hinge bolts (ONLY WORK ON ONE DOOR AT A TIME). It is important that you can enter the Jeep® through the opposite door to tighten the lower door hinge without the door moving. (Fig. 1). Note that image is for 1997-2006 TJ's. 1987 1995 YJ's mount in the same general location except that the side bars mount to the front of the windshield hinge rather than the side as shown.






(3) When you remove the lower door hinge a backing plate (Fig.2) will come loose. Enter the Jeep® from the opposite side to access the plate. You will need it in step #4. This step is the same for both TJ's and YJ's.






(4) Using the supplied front upright ¼ x 20 Allen head bolt and a ¾" flat washer, attach the front upright to the Jeep®. You will need a partner to place the factory backing plate (Fig.2) into the lower door hinge in location before the lower door bolts are attached (DO NOT OPEN THE DOOR YOU ARE WORKING ON! ENTER FROM THE OTHER SIDE!!). Tighten the bolts for the upright and repeat the process for the other side. (Fig.3). Note: Images of are for 1997 – 2006 TJ's. Location of the front bars will be the same for the 1987-1995 YJ except that the upper mount attaches to the front of the windshield hinge.



- (5) Remove the factory rear bumper and bolts.
- (6) Insert the bolts with flat washers through the rear bumper. Do not install the nuts at this time. Just use the bolts to hold the bumper back in place.
- (7) Insert the front overhead bar (straight bar) into the front upright. Insert a 1/4/20 x 2.5" Allen head bolt with flat washer, through the bar and upright. Then place another flat washer, lock washer and lock nut on the bar. **DO NOT TIGHTEN.** Have an assistant hold the bar in place for steps #8 and #9 (Scratches to the vehicles paint could result if an assistant is not used). (Fig.4)



(8) Repeat step 5 for the rear overhead bar (curved bar) **DO NOT TIGHTEN**. (Fig.5)




Figure 6 – Uprights installed, DO NOT TIGHTEN.

(9) Insert the rear upright into the rear overhead bar. Position the rear upright on the backside of the bumper bolts. Install a flat washer and locking nut on the rear upright bolt. **DO NOT TIGHTEN**. Install the 1/4/20 x 2.5" Allen head bolt with a flat washer, through the upright as in steps #7 and #8. **DO NOT TIGHTEN**. (Fig.6). This step is the same for both TJ's and YJ's.



Important, do not tighten until the cross bars are installed.

- (10) Option Body Lift Spacers If your vehicle has a body lift use the spacers to separate the lower upright from the rear overhead bar. 1" 2" and 3" spacers are provided.
- (11) Repeat steps #7 #9 for the opposite side.
- (12) Locate the front cross bar (shorter) and install foam gasket to the crossbar ends.
- (13) Place the front cross bar on the upright. Insert the ¼" x 3 3/8" knob bolt through the cross bar. Tighten the bolt with plastic cross bar knob and Allen key supplied. (Fig.7) Repeat on opposite side. It may be necessary for an assistant to put pressure on the uprights to get them in the proper location for the cross bars to attach. (Fig.8) Repeat the cross bar step for the middle and rear cross bars.
- (14) **TIGHTEN ALL BOLTS AT THIS TIME.** After a few days driving with the rack installed check all bolts for proper tightness. If loose, retighten.
