

- Always make sure you have a clean, dry and well lit work area.
- Always remove jewelry, loose fitting clothing and wear protective gloves and eye protection.


Some products have been designed to work together with factory rear sensor systems, factory forward facing sensor systems and factory air bags.



Step-1 If equipped remove the fasteners securing the sound bar, disconnect the wiring and position the sound bar out of the way.

Step-2 Remove both front roof panels.

Step-3 Remove the two Torx head screws that secure the hard top at the B-pillar (near the top of the front doors) using a #40 Torx bit socket.

Step-4 Open the swing gate all the way to ensure clearance of the rear window glass. Lift the rear window glass.

Step-5 Remove the six Torx head screws that secure the hard top to the vehicle (along the interior body side) using a #40 Torx head driver.


Step-6 With the hard top in place on the vehicle. Lift only the front of the hard top several inches and position wood blocks or similar underneath for support, this will allow access for installation of the front and rear brackets.


Warning: To prevent bodily injury or damage to the vehicle, ensure the hardtop will remain securely in place during the SRM Mounting Bracket Kit installation process.



Step-7 On the driver side of the vehicle, use a 13mm socket and remove (1) screw securing the center crossbar brace to the top of the sport bar, (Fig 1).

Step-8 Remove the paper backing from one of the rubber pads. With the adhesive side down, align the rubber pad with the top of the driver side front bracket, and stick the rubber pad in place on the driver side front bracket, (Fig 2). Apply firm pressure for about 30 seconds, as the adhesive needs to bond with the mounting surface, and it needs pressure to do this.








Step-9 Position the driver side front bracket on top of crossbar brace and sport bar tube, (Fig 3).

Align the holes and attach the front of the bracket and cross bar brace to the sport bar using (1) M8 x 35mm hex bolt, (1) M8 lock washer and (1) M8 flat washer, (Fig 4).

Attach the rear of the front bracket to the sport bar using (1) 3/8" x 3 ½" hex bolt, (2) 3/8" flat washers, (1) 3/8" lock washer and (1) 3/8" hex nut, (Fig 4). Tighten the nuts and bolts. Repeat steps 7 through 9 for the passenger side front bracket.

Step-10 On the driver side of the vehicle, use a 13mm socket and remove (2) screws securing the rear crossbar brace to the sport bar, (Fig 5).

Step-11 Remove the paper backing from one of the rubber pads. With the adhesive side down, align the rubber pad with the top of the driver side rear bracket, and stick the rubber pad in place on the bracket, (Fig 6). Apply firm pressure for about 30 seconds, as the adhesive needs to bond with the mounting surface, and it needs pressure to do this.












Step-12 Position the driver side rear bracket on top of crossbar brace, align the holes and attach the rear bracket and crossbar brace to the sport bar using (2) M8 x 35mm hex bolts, (2) M8 lock washers and (2) M8 flat washers, (Fig 7). Tighten the bolts.

Repeat steps 10 through 12 for the passenger side rear bracket.





Step-13 Remove the supports and lower the hard top back into position on the vehicle. Install and tighten all of the hard top fasteners removed in step 3 and 5.

Step-14 Use the (2) holes in the top of the driver side front bracket as a guide and mark the center of each hole on the interior side of the hard top. Drill a small hole first through the hard top from the interior side, then from the exterior side of the hard top enlarge the drilled hole to 3/8". Repeat for the passenger side front bracket.




Driver Side

Step-15 Use the rear hole in the top of the driver side rear bracket as a guide and mark the center of the hole on the interior side of the hard top. Drill a small hole through the hard top from the interior side, then from the exterior side of the hard top enlarge the hole to 3/8".







Step-16 Attach the driver side rear stand-off bracket to the drilled hole in the hard top and rear bracket using (1) 3/8" x 1 ½" hex head bolt and (1) 3/8" hex nut. Align the stand-off bracket so it is positioned parallel with the reinforcement rib of the hardtop then snug the nut and bolt.

Step-17 Use the front hole in the stand-off bracket as a guide and mark the center of the hole on the hard top. Remove the nut, bolt and stand-off bracket.


Step-18 Drill a small hole through the hard top from the exterior side, confirm the drilled hole aligns with the front hole in the driver side rear bracket, then enlarge the small drilled hole to 3/8". Repeat step 16 through 18 for the passenger side rear bracket.








Step-19 Working from the exterior side of the hard top, remove the paper backing from the remaining rubber pads. With the adhesive side down, align the rubber pads with the holes drilled in the hard top and stick the rubber pads in place on the hard top, (Fig 15). Apply firm pressure on the rubber pads for about 30 seconds, as the adhesive needs to bond with the vehicle hard top, and it needs pressure to do this. Note: Clean the area where the holes were drilled in the hard top prior to installing the rubber pads as dirt and dust will prevent the rubber pads from sticking to the hard top.



Step-20 Attach the driver side rear stand off bracket to the hard top and rear bracket using (2) 3/8" x 1 1/2" hex head bolts, (4) 3/8" flat washers, (2) 3/8" lock Washers and (2) 3/8" hex nuts, (Fig 16 & 17). Snug but do not tighten the nuts and bolts. Repeat step 16 for the driver and passenger front stand off brackets and the passenger side rear stand off bracket.


Note: The holes drilled in the hard top for the brackets should be waterproofed to prevent a leak. Apply automotive silicone sealant on top of each mounting hole on the hard top prior to installing the stand off bracket, hex bolts, washers and nuts.




Step-21Reference the measurements of the SRM Bracket Kit stand off brackets an install (2) ¼" x ¾" hex head bolts (Supplied with SRM Roof Rack) in the 4 crossbars that will align with the stand off brackets, (Fig 19).




Step-22 With assistance, align the ¼" x ¾" hex head bolts installed in the SRM Roof Rack crossbars with the holes in the standoff brackets then position the SRM Roof Rack assembly on top of the stand off brackets, (Fig 20 & 21).





Step-23 Attach SRM Roof Rack crossbars to each stand off bracket using the ¼" x ¾" hex bolts, (2) ¼" flat washers, (2) ¼" lock washers and (2) ¼" hex nuts supplied with the SRM Roof Rack, (Fig 22 & 23).



Step-24 Tighten all nuts and bolts securing the SRM Roof Rack to the stand off brackets then tighten all nuts and bolts securing the SRM Bracket Kit to the vehicle hard top and sport bar.





LIMITED WARRANTY

Go Rhino warrants to Buyer that for a period of five (5) years from the date of shipment of the product(s) ("Warranty Period") for black finishes and chrome finishes, that such products will materially conform to the specifications set forth in Go Rhino's specifications in effect as of the date of shipment(s) and will be free from material defects in material workmanship.

Go Rhino warrants to Buyer that for the life of the product(s) from the date of shipment of the product(s) ("Warranty Period") for polished stainless steel finished products purchased after April 2004, that such products will materially conform to the specifications set forth in Go Rhino's specifications in effect as of the date of shipments and will be free from material defects in material workmanship.

Warranty claims must be accompanied with the original invoice and photos of the product. It is the customer's responsibility to clean regularly and protect finish with regular applications of a nonabrasive polish that is compatible with the product's finish.

This warranty covers the cost of the product only and does not include the cost of removal, installation, third party modifications or shipping of the product. In no event shall Go Rhino be liable to buyer or any third party for any damage or harm caused by the product or use thereof, regardless of whether such damages were foreseeable and whether or not Go Rhino has been advised of the possibility of such damages, not withstanding the failure of any agreed or other remedy of its essential purpose. This warranty is void if the product shows signs of alteration, misuse, mishandling, improper care, neglect, improper application and/or damage due to improper installation.

With respect to any such product(s) during the limited warranty period, Go Rhino shall, in its sole discretion, either: (i) provide a one-time repair or replacement of such products (or the defective part) or (ii) credit or refund the price of such products at the pro rata contract rate provided that, if Go Rhino so requests, Buyer shall, at Go Rhino's expense, return such product(s) to Go Rhino. The remedies shall be the Buyer's sole and exclusive remedy and Go Rhino's entire liability for any breach of the limited warrant(ies).

This warranty does not cover exposed welds

Finish warranty covers peeling, flaking, or cracking. Washing all finishes regularly with car wash soap and rinsing well with water is the best method for maintaining the finish on your products. You must also protect the finish with nonabrasive automotive wax on a regular basis. The use of any compound which contains abrasives becomes a self-defeating exercise as the compound scratches the finish and opens it to corrosion. The use of harsh chemicals used to remove bugs and tar may also cause the finish to fail and should be avoided.
