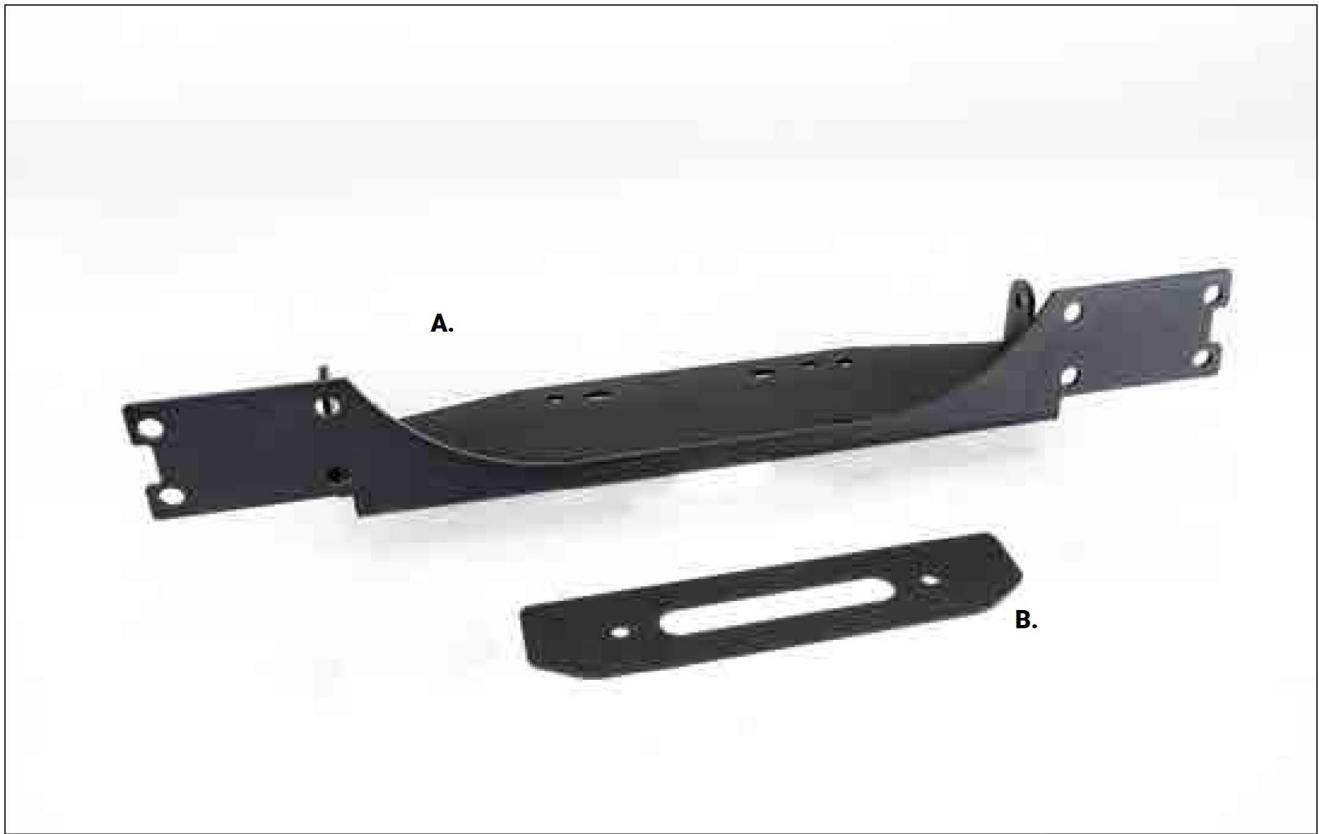

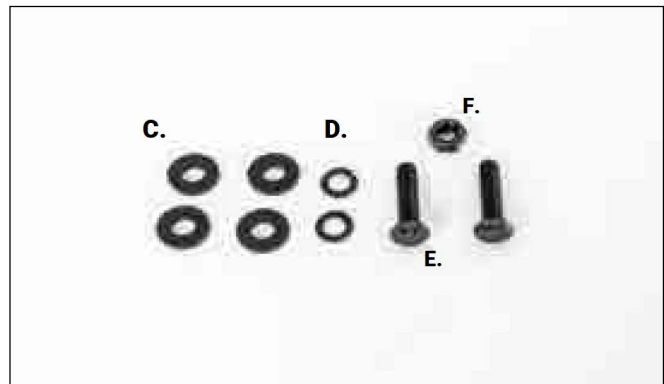


REQUIRED TOOLS:

- Safety Glasses
- Gloves
- 16mm Socket
- 17mm Socket
- 18mm Socket
- T45 Torx Bit
- Ratchet
- Pry Tool

KIT CONTENT LIST:

- A. Winch Plate Plate (1)
- B. Fairlead Support Bracket (1)
- C. M10 Flat Washer/Spacer (8)
- D. M10 Lock Washer (4)
- E. M10 x 1.50 x 40mm Hex Head Bolt (4)
- F. M10 Hex Nut (2)



STEP 1



Put on Gloves and Safety Glasses. Locate the fog light harness plug on the right side of the vehicle frame and disconnect it. (FIG 1) Locate the eight (8) nuts on the backside of the front bumper. There are four (4) nuts on each

STEP 2



Using an 18mm socket, remove the eight (8) 18mm nuts from the backside of the front bumper. (FIG 3) Retain these nuts to be used during reassembly. Locate and remove the 2 plastic push-pin rivets retaining the plastic frame cover. (FIG 4) This will not be reinstalled with the winch plate installed.

STEP 3



Align the winch plate with the bumper mounts and front frame rails. (FIG 5) With the four holes for each bumper mount aligned, notice the mounting tab on each side of the horizontal flat surface should line up approximately with a threaded mounting point on the inside of the frame rails. (FIG 6)

STEP 4



Having an assistant hold the winch plate as described in previous step, place an M10 hex head bolt with an M10 lock washer through the hole in the tab of the winch plate. There will be a gap between the tab and the threaded mounting point. (FIG 7) Use one or more M10 flat washer / spacer on each side to fill in the space and loosely thread bolt in to

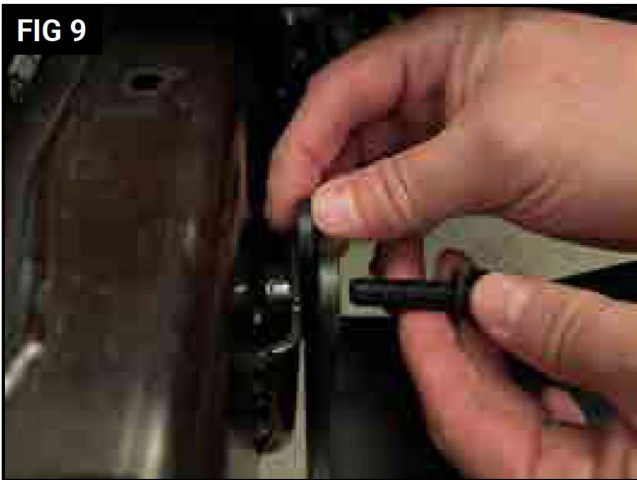

Repeat the previous step on the other side. (FIG 9) It is ok if the number of flat washers / spacers are not the same on both sides. (FIG 10)

Make sure that the front of the winch plate is in the proper alignment so that all 4 holes are lined up on each side. (FIG 11) Put an M10 bolt and nut in the upper, outside corner spot to hold the plate in place (these bolt will be removed before reinstalling the bumper). Tighten the M10 bolts. Torque to 74 ft. lbs. **Note:** This is a great time to install your

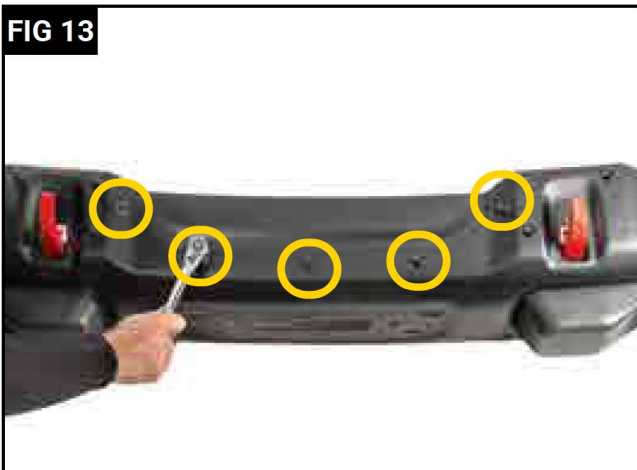

Using the T45 Torx Bit, remove the 5 torx button head bolts and remove the winch block off plate from the bumper. (FIG 13) This will not be reused in the installation. Use a pry tool to disconnect the 6 tabs to remove the fairlead block off plate. (FIG 14)

Place the fairlead support bracket on the outside of the bumper. The fairlead support bracket should nest onto the bumper. Use the hardware from the fairlead from your winch to mount and secure fairlead and fairlead support bracket. (FIG 15) Note: If you are not installing a fairlead, the fairlead support bracket can be installed using two (2)

Remove the two alignment M10 bolts installed in Step 5. Lift and reinstall the bumper back onto the bumper mount on the frame rails. Make sure all eight (8) bolts are through the mount holes in the winch plate and bumper mount. Tighten the original bolts using an 18mm Socket and ratchet. Torque nuts to 67 ft. lbs. (FIG 17)
