



TO AVOID OVER INFLATION, NEVER LEAVE COMPRESSOR UNATTENDED OR EXCEED RECOMMENDED PRESSURE ON OBJECTS TO BE INFLATED.



BEFORE YOU USE



Place the compressor on a flat, level dry surface. Locate the air filter. Place the threaded portion of the air filter into the threaded hole on the vented portion of the compressor. Tighten by turning in a clockwise motion. You only need to finger tighten. Do not over tighten. If the compressor needs to be assembled to the mounting plate, use the four rubber grommets to mount the legs of the compressor to the four holes in the mounting plate. The mounting plate has four rubber feet on the bottom to stabilize the compressor.

USAGE



Put on safety glasses. Attach the ¼" quick connect coupler on the coiled hose to the ¼" quick connect stud on the air compressor by pulling the retaining ring under the rubber covering back. Slide the fittings together firmly. While holding the fittings together, slide the retaining ring closed toward the compressor to lock.



Connect the red power clip to a positive 12-volt source, such as the battery in your vehicle. Connect the black power clip to a negative ground point. Connect the chuck by squeezing the lever and pressing the chuck onto the tire valve stem. Switch the compressor to the on position. Air will begin to flow. Watch the gauge closely. When you get to the desired pressure switch the compressor to off. Squeeze the lever and release from the valve stem. You can check the tire pressure by attaching the chuck and reading the gauge without turning the system on.

This **Limited Warranty** is the only warranty made in connection with your purchase. Res-Q neither assumes nor authorizes any vendor, retailer or other person or entity to assume for it any other obligation or liability in connection with this product or Limited Warranty. This Limited Warranty does not apply and is not cumulative to any accessory or part distributed by Res-Q for which the Manufacturer provides a separate written warranty.

What is Covered:

Subject to the terms, exclusions and limitations herein and with respect only to Res-Q branded accessories first sold in the United States, Res-Q warrants to the initial retail purchaser only that your Res-Q accessory shall be free of defects in material and workmanship: for a period of three (3) years from date of retail purchase.

This **Limited Warranty** is not assignable and shall terminate upon sale of the Res-Q accessory or other transfer to third persons.

All other warranties are hereby disclaimed, except to the extent prohibited by applicable law in which case any implied warranty of merchantability or fitness for a particular purpose on this product is limited to three (3) years from date of initial retail sale. Res-Q reserves the rights to: (a.) require invoice or other proof your accessory is within the terms of this Limited Warranty as a condition of warranty service and, (b.) make future revisions to this product and Limited Warranty without prior notice or obligation to upgrade your product.

What is Not Covered:

Your Res-Q Limited Warranty does not cover products or parts Res-Q determines to have been damaged by or subjected to: (a.) installation damage, alteration, modification, combination with other parts, failure to maintain or improper repair or service, (b.) normal wear & tear, cosmetic damage or damage from moisture or water immersion, (c.) Acts of God, accidents, misuse, negligence, inadequate mounting or impact with vehicle(s), obstacles or other aspects of the environment, (d.) theft, vandalism or other intentional damage.

Remedy Limited to Repair/Replacement:

The exclusive remedy provided hereunder shall, upon Res-Q inspection and at our option, be either repair or replacement of product or parts (new or refurbished) covered under this Limited Warranty. Customers requesting warranty consideration should first contact Res-Q to obtain a RGA number (610-701-3336). All labor, removal, shipping and installation costs are customer's responsibility.

Other Limitations - Exclusion of Damages - Your Rights Under State Law:

In consideration of the purchase price paid, neither Res-Q nor any independent Res-Q distributor/licensee are responsible for any time loss, rental costs, or for any incidental, consequential, punitive or other damages you may have or incur in connection with any part or product purchased. Your exclusive remedy hereunder for covered parts is repair/replacement as described above.

This **Limited Warranty** gives you specific rights. You may also have other rights that vary from state to state. For example, some states do not allow limitations of how long an implied warranty lasts and /or do not allow the exclusion or limitation of incidental or consequential damages, so the limitations and exclusions herein may not apply to you.
