

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! IMPORTANT NOTE

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WARNING

Chock all four wheels and make sure parking brake is engaged before starting this install. Failure to do so could result in serious injury.

Step 1: Check Box Contents.

Open the box containing your Ford Bronco HD Pivot, check all parts against the Bill of Materials outlined in the first pages of these instructions.


If anything is missing, contact Smittybilt Technical Support immediately.



Step 2: License Plate Removal.

First remove the **2X 19mm bolts (a)** holding the license plate mount and disconnect the license plate light by pulling the red tab out first and then remove the plug.

NOTE: If you do not have a license plate relocation bracket continue to step 2.



Step 3: Remove Spare Tire.

Next using an impact wrench remove the **3X 19mm lug nuts (b)** and remove the spare tire.





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Step 4: Disconnect Tailgate Wires.

Open the tailgate (*c*) and with a plastic pry tool remove the plastic panel starting from the right side. Once panel is removed disconnect the two wires (*d*), next press the plastic tabs (*e*) to remove the rubber grommet and wire harness.



Step 5: Tire Carrier Removal.

After the wires are disconnected remove the **8X 13mm bolts (*g*)** and remove the tire carrier.


! IMPORTANT NOTE

Spare tire rubber bump stops (*h*) will need to be removed. To remove the bump stops use a Phillips screwdriver to take out the push pins, after pins are removed than you can pull out the bump stops by hand.





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Step 6: Access Tail Light Bolts.

Open the tailgate and remove the **4X Phillips push pins (h)** and the **2X 10mm screws (i)**, now remove the plastic panel (j) to access the taillight bolts.




Step 7: Tail Light Removal.

Once the plastic panel is off remove the **2X 8mm screws (k)**. Using a plastic pry tool remove the outer panel (l) by prying from top left corner and slowly pulling the panel out, to access the remaining two screws.



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
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Step 8: Removing the taillight.



With the panel off remove the remaining **2X 10mm screws (m)**.

Before removing the taillight completely disconnect the light bulb wire (*n*).




Step 9: Removing the hinges.

Before removing any bolts remove the damper from the tailgate (*o*). Close the tailgate and wedge a block or piece of wood between the tailgate and the bumper, wrap the block with a rag to protect the paint (*p*). Using a **T40 torx socket** remove the **4X screws (q)**, with a **13mm socket and wrench** remove the **6X bolts (r)** that hold the hinges.



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Step 10: Installing HD Pivot.

Install the HD pivot to where the stock hinges were mounted using the **6X M8x1.25x40 bolts (s)**, hand tighten the bolts to allow room for adjustment.

Next install the **4X M8x1.25x50 (t)** to the tailgate and hand tighten these bolts as well.


! IMPORTANT NOTE

This step will require 2 people to complete.



Step 11: Reinstall Tire Carrier.

Install the stock tire carrier to the HD pivot, place the sheet metal spacer (*u*) behind the tire carrier on the left side (highlighted in yellow) and install the **8X M8x1.25x35 bolts** and tighten by hand.



! IMPORTANT NOTE

Be sure to not pinch license plate light wire when installing tire carrier.



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Step 12: Adjusting the tailgate.

Adjust the tailgate so that it is parallel (yellow line) and tighten all the bolts (**torque to 23ft lbs.**).

Connect the two wires inside the tailgate and reinstall the rubber grommet and plastic panel

! IMPORTANT NOTE

When tailgate closes top and bottom gap (Yellow Arrows) should be similar, if not adjust as needed. Once the tailgate is adjusted properly go back to steps 3 to 8 in reverse order and reinstall the taillight and all the plastic panels.



Step 13: Bump Stop Spacer.

To install place the spacer (v) behind the rubber bump stop and mount to the tailgate with **OE Phillips push pin**.

NOTE: This step is optional. wire when installing tire carrier.



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Step 14: Reinstall Spare Tire.

Reinstall the spare tire (and license plate relocation bracket if owned) and tighten the lug nuts.

Your installation is now complete.



