NOTICE

Mesh Trail Windows are designed to replace your current soft top windows with a mesh window. For this product to work you will need an original factory soft top which includes rear corner support pieces that will be used to install this product. *If you do not have a factory soft top this product will not work.*

WARNING

Important Safety information

Your MasterTop® Mesh Trail Window is intended to be used with other MasterTop Products to increase the fair weather enjoyment of your off-road capable vehicle. Before installation, please take a moment to review the following safety information and installation instructions. Before you begin Installation:

We are excited that you have chosen the MasterTop Mesh Trail Windows. Please note that it is important that you become familiar with the installation process of these windows by reading the following instruction sheet and warnings thoroughly.

When unpacking, check to make sure all parts are included. If any part is missing or broken, please call MasterTop customer service at 720-575-5440.

Required Soft Top Components Needed for installation of the Trail Mesh Windows:

This product requires the use of the factory rear driver and passenger side soft top corner supports. Please see below on how to remove your current damaged window from these supports.

Repairing your Rear Window: The Trail Mesh Rear Window attaches to the rear corner supports just like the factory Window. Remove the factory rear window and replace it with the Trail Mesh Window.

Step 1: Removing the Rear Corner Support from the Factory Soft Top Side Windows



Put on safety glasses. Remove your rear window from your vehicle. When you remove this window there will be a rear corner support installed on the window with five "T-clips" (FIG 1 & 2). On a soft towel or sheet, lay the quarter window with the inside of the windows facing up (FIG 2). Detach the plastic slot that is holding the corner support from the window (FIG 3). Once the plastic slot is removed from the corner support, T-clips are to be trimmed/snapped off and removed (FIG 4). These T-clips are made of brittle plastic so it should be easy to break them off simply by bending them back and forth. If you have difficulty, use a pair of wire cutters to easily cut them off.

Step 1: Installing your Mesh Trail Windows



On a soft towel, lay the Trail Mesh Side Window with the inside facing up and the rear corner support in front of the window (FIG 5). Line the 5 holes on the window up with the five holes on the rear corner support and insert the 5 included screws. The screw heads should be facing out (FIG 6).

Once the screws are inserted lift up the corner support as shown in FIG 7. Using a 9mm socket/wrench and a Phillip screw driver, install the included nuts into the screws and tighten (FIG 8).

Re-insert the plastic slot onto the corner support as shown in FIG 9.

The Trail Mesh Window should now be installed on the corner support (FIG 10). Repeat on the other side.

Once the Side Quarter Window is installed on the rear corner supports, the rear window can be re-installed the same way as your factory windows. Install the quarter Windows first, remove the rear factory window and then the Trail Mesh rear window attaches to the rear corner pieces.



Note: If necessary, to help you insert the window slot onto the corner support, you may want to use an ice scrapper or plastic putty knife to open a little the window slot, then insert the corner support (FIG 11).

Remedy Limited to Repair/Replacement: The exclusive remedy provided hereunder shall, upon MasterTop inspection and at MasterTop's option, be either repair or replacement of product or parts (new or refurbished) covered under this Limited Warranty.
