SEAT COVER INSTALLATION - FRONT SEATS

Prepare your seat covers for installation. Make sure to unbuckle all straps and unzip all zippers on your seat covers prior to installation. Remove front headrests by depressing the release tabs at the base of the headrest posts and lift up on headrest. Front seat covers are designed specifically for the passenger and drivers side of the vehicle and are not interchangeable. The Tru-Fit sew bar tags on front seats always face to the center of the vehicle (Fig 1).








Start by slipping the seat cover over the back of your vehicle's seat and pulling it down all the way over seatback. Ensure that the holes for the headrest in the covers line up with the grommets in the seat. Install the headrest covers and reinstall the headrests (Fig 2). Next, tuck the connecting flaps of the seat cover between the seat base and seat back. Folding the seat forward may make this process easier (Fig 3). Fit the seat base cover snug around the bottom seat base. Install the cover over the seat base and pass the connecting velcro straps between the seat back. Make sure the straps are tucked all the way through the crevice between the seat back and base. Underneath the seat, connect and tighten the three velcro straps from the back of the seat base cover (Fig 4). Pull and secure the three velcro strips under the seats to the back of the seats. Finish installation by adjusting the seat covers around and behind all seat levers, adjusters, covers, and trim

SEAT COVER INSTALLATION - REAR SEATS





Rear seats are equipped with a 60/40 bench split. The 60 split is the passenger side and the 40 split is the drivers side. Start on the passenger side. Slide the fully opened seat cover over the seat while extending the seat belt (Fig 1). Place the cover over the back of the seat. Tuck the connecting flaps of the seat cover between the seat base and seat back. Fold the seat forward. Zipper the seat cover up. Attach the connecting flap on the seat cover (Fig 2). Slide the smaller of the two rear seat back covers (40 portion) over the seat back. Velcro around headrest post. Tuck the connecting flaps of the seat cover between the seat base and the seat back. Finally install the rear seat base covers by placing them over the seat bases. Connect the velcro strip under the seat base and snug for a tight fit.





Finish installation by adjusting the seat covers around and behind all seat levers, adjusters, covers, and trim. Seat covers can be carefully tucked under and around the headrest grommets. This will provide a more finished look and retain access to headrest release tabs (Fig 3). Finally, install headrest covers and reinstall headrests (Fig 4).

Care of your product:

Periodic adjustments to the seat covers may be necessary as the cover breaks in and conforms to your vehicle's seat. Seat covers can be spot cleaned with mild soap and water and a soft bristle brush. Do not machine wash. Sunlight will naturally fade leather over time. Seat covers are warrantied against defects in workmanship and materials, but not for fading due to normal UV exposure.

What is Covered:

Subject to the terms, exclusions and limitations herein and with respect only to Tru-Fit branded accessories first sold in the United States, Tru-Fit warrants to the initial retail purchaser only that your Tru-Fit accessory shall be free of defects in material and workmanship: for a period of three (3) years from date of retail purchase.

This **Limited Warranty** is not assignable and shall terminate upon sale of the vehicle upon which the Tru-Fit accessory is installed or other transfer to third persons.

All other warranties are hereby disclaimed, except to the extent prohibited by applicable law in which case any implied warranty of merchantability or fitness for a particular purpose on this product is limited to three (3) years from date of initial retail sale. What is Not Covered:

Remedy Limited to Repair/Replacement:
