

Return/Exchange Procedure


- 1. Email <u>xk@xkglow.com</u> to notify us of the product issue as well as the item number and name of customer on invoice.
- 2. We will send you the trouble-shooting guide to fix the issue, or to narrow down which of the component(s) need to be replaced. If the issue still exists, we will ask you to send back the defective items to be replaced.
- 3. Please send the returned item as instructed, along with claims and a telephone number where you can be reached.
- 4. After the returned item(s) have been accepted and inspected, we will issue a refund or replace the items ASAP. For refunds, item(s) must be sent to XKGLOW within 14 days from date of purchase. Original shipping charges are not refundable.







- 1. **Test Wheel Light:** Before mounting, plug light bar into 4 pin trailer plug. With the vehicle off, turn on hazards and check operation.
- 2. Remove Spare Tire: Carefully remove the spare tire from the back of your vehicle.



- 3. Position Wheel Light: With the spare tire removed, place the wheel light onto the spare tire hub. To prepare routing the wiring, cut off the 4 pin plug. If re-using the 4 pin plug, be sure to leave about 12" of wire on the plug end for crimping/soldering.
- **4.** Route Wiring into Tailgate: Remove the grommet as shown below. Using a ½" drill bit, drill a hole in the center of the grommet. Feed the wiring through the drilled grommet and then insert the wiring and grommet into the hole on the tailgate.







- 5. Route Wiring out of Tailgate: As shown above, remove the plastic trim piece to reveal factory wiring. Using a wire coat hanger, fish Wheel Light wiring through one of the holes shown on the right. Follow factory wiring into the vehicle. Secure wiring with zip ties and reinstall plastic cover.
- **6. Reinstall Spare Tire:** Put the spare tire back on while keeping the Wheel Light centered. Torque lug nuts to factory spec.

Wiring Option 1 - Plug into 4 Pin Trailer Plug:

- 1. Using the supplied butt connectors, crimp the 4 pin plug back onto the wiring harness ensuring that the wire colors match.
- 2. Route 4 pin plug wiring down and out of the vehicle nearest the hinges on the right side of the vehicle. Drop plug down between the body of the vehicle and the bumper.
- 3. Plug the 4 pin plug on the Wheel Light into the 4 pin trailer plug on the truck.
- **4.** Wire in reverse light. Using the supplied red scotchlok, tap the additional white wire into the factory reverse light positive wire behind the right side tail light. See service manual for vehicle's reverse + wire color.
- **5.** Secure any loose wiring.
- 6. Power on vehicle and test functionality.

Wiring Option 2 - Hard Wire into Tail Lights:

- 1. Using the supplied scotchloks, tap the black, red, and green wire into its corresponding wire behind the <u>RIGHT</u> side tail light. See diagram on Page 2 for plug pinout.
- 2. The yellow wire will be tapped into the turn signal positive wire on the <u>LEFT</u> side of the vehicle. The included extension wire is to reach the left side of the vehicle. Use one of the scotchloks to extend the yellow wire and another scotchlok to tap into the left side turn signal positive wire. Route wiring under carpet or the plastic trim pieces at the bottom of the tail gate.
- 3. Wire in reverse light. Using the supplied red scotchlok, tap the additional white wire into the factory reverse light positive wire behind the right side tail light. See service manual for vehicle's reverse + wire color.
- 4. Secure any loose wiring.
- 5. Power on vehicle and test functionality.

If vehicle shows any of the following issues, the dedicated power wire (blue) will need to be connected to 12V.

- Trailer detection warning
- Trailer light out warning
- Tail lamp out warning
- Blind spot detection warning
- Flickering of light bar on any function

Take the BLUE wire coming directly from the 5th wheel light and connect to a constant fused 12V power. This could be directly to the + battery terminal with a dedicated inline fuse or an available 12V wire on the 7 pin trailer plug. Please note: If applicable, 12V wire on the 7 pin trailer plug must be switched to constant-on power to ensure proper function.
