
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

JL Rear Bumper Installation Prep:



Put on safety glasses. Start by removing the factory splash guard. Remove the 6 screws holding the inner shields on, 3 on either side, using a 8mm socket. (FIG 1)



Remove the 8 bolts holding the support brackets on, 4 on either side, using a 16mm socket. (FIG 2)



Disconnect the rear bumper harness by sliding the gray locking tab backwards and depressing the black tab. (FIG 3)



Remove the 4 bumper bolts, 2 on either side, using a 16mm socket. (FIG 4)
Remove stock bumper and set aside.




Remove the original tow hook if equipped using a 21mm socket. (FIG 5) Remove bumper bracket as well. There are 4 bolts total.




Remove the passenger side bumper bracket using a 21mm socket. (FIG 6)

JL Rear Bumper Installation Prep:



Remove the bumpers harness by gently prying on all tie wrap fasteners and disconnecting the license plate light. (FIG 7)



Bumper harness without backup sensors shown. (FIG 8) This bumper is not designed to work with backup sensors. Retain harness for use with optional license plate light (#12066 1100)



Install the license plate mount to the bumper using two M6 screws, two washers and two nuts. (FIG 9) The license plate will be installed with the remaining M6 hardware.



On the passenger side insert the supplied M14 nut plate into the frame rail. (FIG 10) Align the threaded holes in the nut plate with the holes in the frame on the bottom.



JL Rear Bumper Installation:



With the assistance of another person, and with the tailgate partially open lift the bumper and gently rest it on the frame rails. Using the original hardware attach the bumper to the frame starting on the most bottom drivers side bolts (FIG 11) and then the passenger side using the supplied bolts, washers and



lock washers using a 21mm socket (FIG 12). Snug the bottom bolts first, but do not tighten and then insert the original side mounting bolts on both sides. Starting with the bottom bolts, torque all mounting hardware to 105ft-lbs.

Installation is now complete.

Bumper Care:

Your Bumper has been designed and manufactured to provide years of use. However, like any product, general maintenance is required to keep it looking new.

Since the bumper is located on the Rear of the vehicle, it is subject to potential rock chips and other debris potentially causing portions of the paint to chip off. We recommend using a textured or gloss black spray paint sprayed on a piece of cardboard and Q-Tip to gently fill in

these chips. This will prevent any corrosion from forming. On all bumpers there is a chance of some surface corrosion showing over time due to metal particles being embedded in the paint. This surface corrosion is easily removed by a non-abrasive cleaner/polish and a soft bristle brush (not a metal brush!).

For bumpers with a textured finish, wash only with soapy water and avoid other waxes and polishes.
