





Aluminum JL Rear Bumper Installation Prep:



Put on safety glasses. Start by removing the factory splash guard. Remove the 6 screws holding the inner shields on, 3 on either side, using a 8mm socket. (FIG 1)



Remove the 8 bolts holding the support brackets on, 4 on either side, using a 16mm socket. (FIG 2)



Disconnect the rear bumper harness by sliding the gray locking tab backwards and depressing the black tab. (FIG 3)



Remove the 4 bumper bolts, 2 on either side, using a 16mm socket. (FIG 4)
Remove stock bumper and set aside.



Remove the original tow hook if equipped using a 21mm socket. (FIG 5) Remove bumper bracket as well. There are 4 bolts total.




Remove the passenger side bumper bracket using a 21mm socket. (FIG 6)

Aluminum JL Rear Bumper Installation Prep:




Using four M14 bolts and washers loosely install the driver's side bumper bracket using a 22mm socket. (FIG 7)



On the passenger side insert the nut plate into the frame rail. (FIG 8)




Using two M14 bolts and washers, two M12 bolts and washers loosely install the passenger side bumper bracket. (FIG 9) You can reach up into frame rail and hold the nut plate for easier installation.



Using a 16mm socket remove the original hitch wiring plug from the frame. (FIG 10)
Save these bolts for re-use.




Re-install the hitch plug with the supplied spacer and original hardware. (FIG 11) Or, if you need more clearance for your hitch plug, use both provided spacers and the supplied M10 x 50 bolts.




Remove the bumpers harness by gently prying on all tie wrap fasteners and disconnecting the license plate light. (FIG 12)

Aluminum JL Rear Bumper Installation:



Bumper harness **without** backup sensors shown. (FIG 13) This bumper is **not** designed to work with backup sensors. Retain harness for use with optional license plate light (*12066 1100)



Install the license plate mount to the bumper using two M6 screws, four washers and two nuts. (FIG 14) The license plate will be installed with the remaining M6 hardware.



Loosely install the tow hooks through the bumper and into the bumper brackets with the supplied M10 allen head bolts and washers using a 6mm hex key. (FIG 15)



Once the bumper is aligned to your liking you may now tighten the M14 hardware to 105 ft/lbs and the M12 hardware to 65 ft/lbs.



Finally, you may now tighten the M10 allen head hardware through the tow hooks to 55 ft/lbs.

Installation is now complete.

Bumper Care:

Your Bumper has been designed and manufactured to provide years of use. However, like any product, general maintenance is required to keep it looking new.

Since the bumper is located on the front of the vehicle, it is subject to potential rock chips and other debris potentially causing portions of the paint to chip off. We recommend using a textured or gloss black spray paint sprayed on a piece of cardboard and O-Tip to gently fill in

these chips. This will prevent any corrosion from forming. On all bumpers there is a chance of some surface corrosion showing over time due to metal particles being embedded in the paint. This surface corrosion is easily removed by a non-abrasive cleaner/polish and a soft bristle brush (not a metal brush!).

For bumpers with a textured finish, wash only with soapy water and avoid other waxes and polishes.

This **Limited Warranty** is not assignable and shall terminate upon sale of the vehicle upon which the Quadratec accessory is installed or other transfer third persons.

All other warranties are hereby disclaimed, except to the extent prohibited by applicable law in which case any implied warranty of merchantability or fitness for a particular purpose on this product is limited to 3 year from date of initial retail sale. What is Not Covered:

Acts of God, accidents, misuse, negligence, inadequate mounting or impact with vehicle(s), obstacles or other aspects of the environment, (d.) theft, vandalism or other intentional damage.

Remedy Limited to Repair/Replacement:
The exclusive remedy provided hereunder shall, upon Quadratec inspection and at Quadratec's option, be either repair or replacement of product or parts (new or refurbished) covered under this Limited Warranty.
